

- Projects incorporate SEL
- Youth Input (time and type of programming)
- Open Studio, food & celebration

Digital Tools:

- Cell phone & YouTube to share lessons for Cyber Clubhouse
- Zoom "as stage" to create & connect
- Zoom camera, video, audio for content creation
