### OUR AGREEMENTS

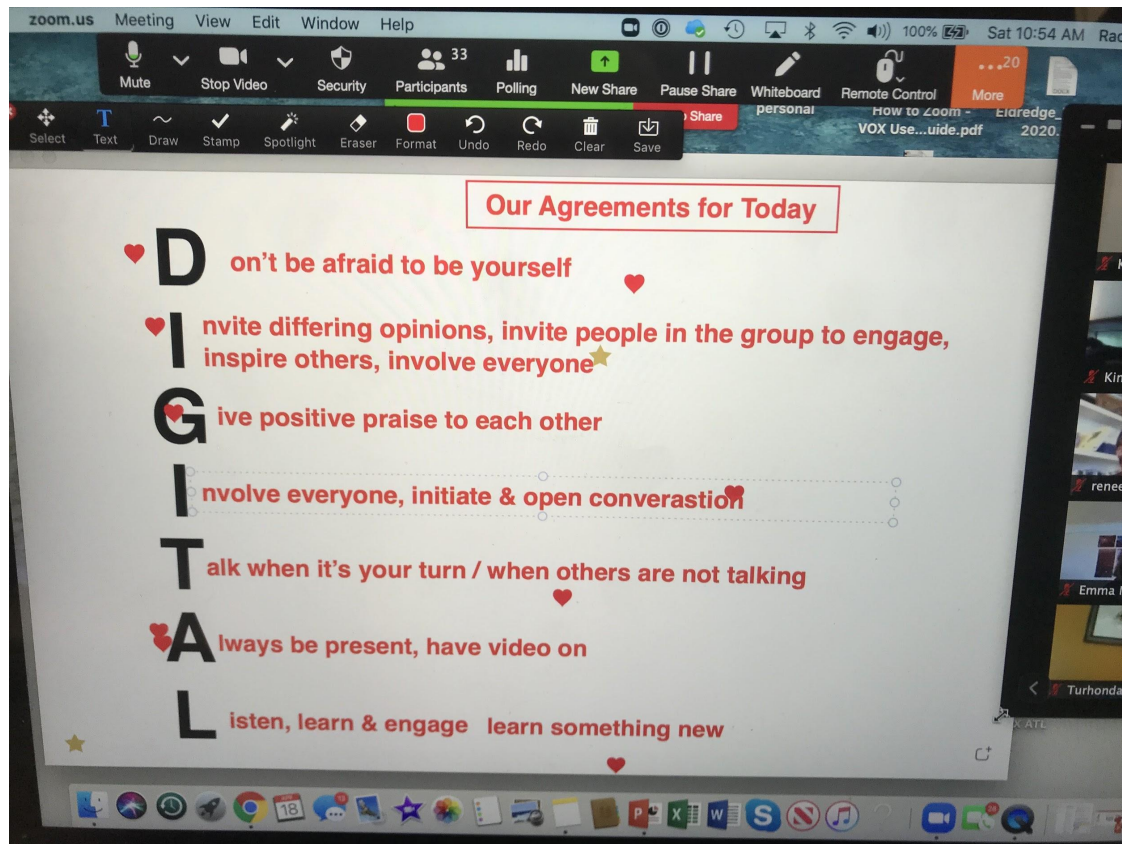
- Show Appreciation

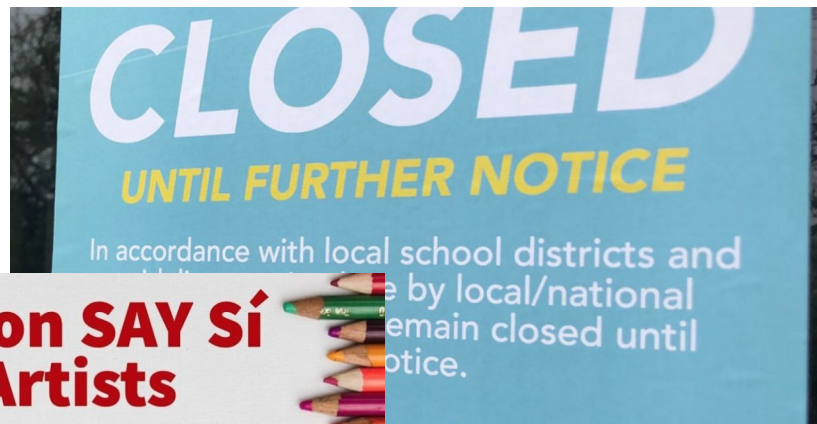

-  Positive Relationships
-  Hands-on Skillbuilding

## Digital Tools

- Text, e-newsletter to connect with youth & families
- Trello for projects & admin
- Google Hangouts & now Zoom to connect in program cohorts (maintain programming sessions)

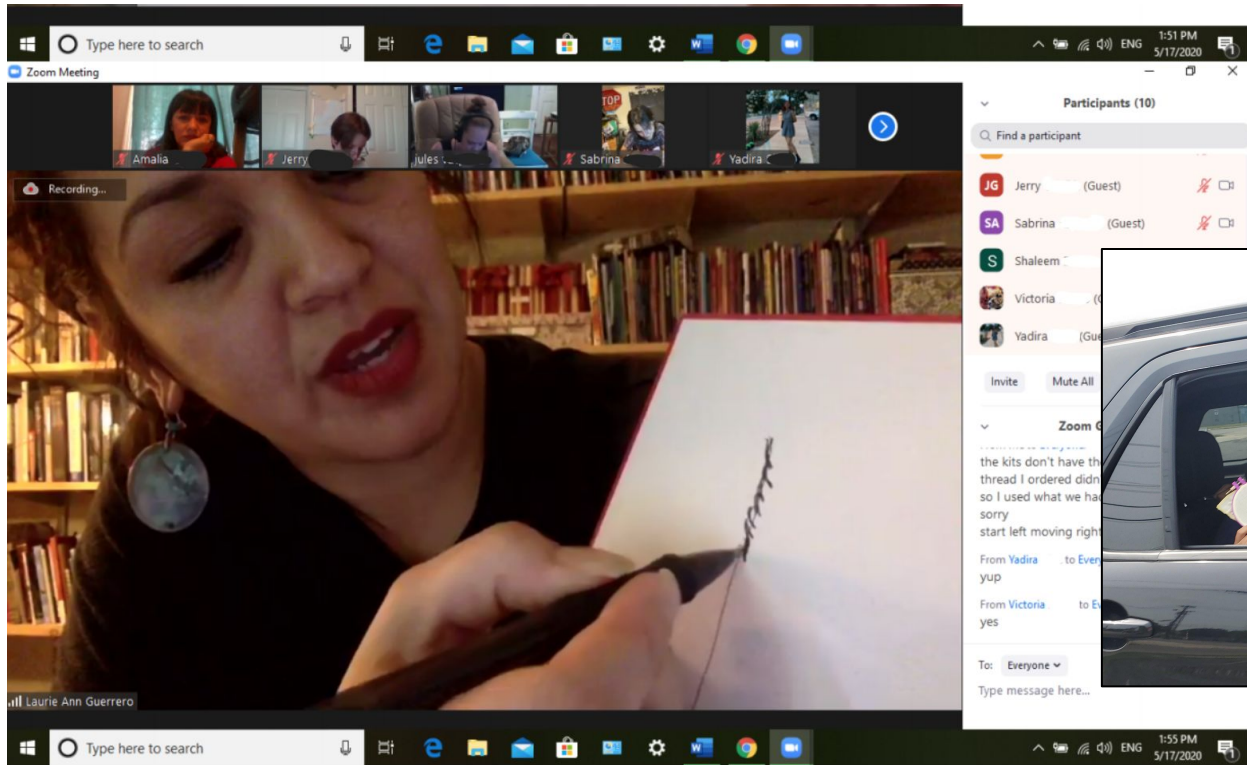

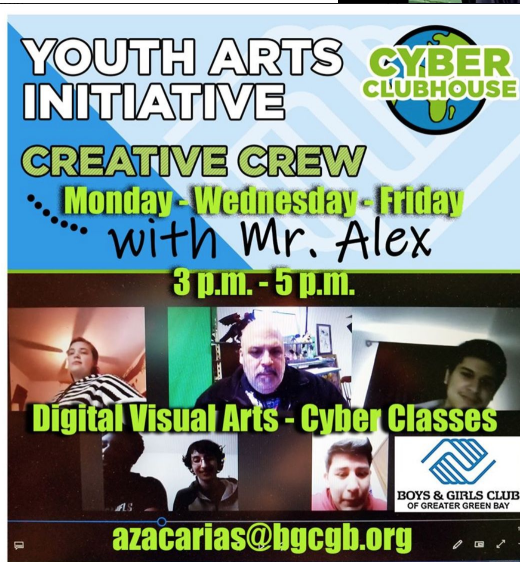
## Tips & Tricks through the lens of a recent pizza party

-  Projects incorporate SEL
-  Youth Input (time and type of programming)
-  Open Studio, food & celebration

### Digital Tools:

- Cell phone & YouTube to share lessons for Cyber Clubhouse
- Zoom “as stage” to create & connect
- Zoom camera, video, audio for content creation

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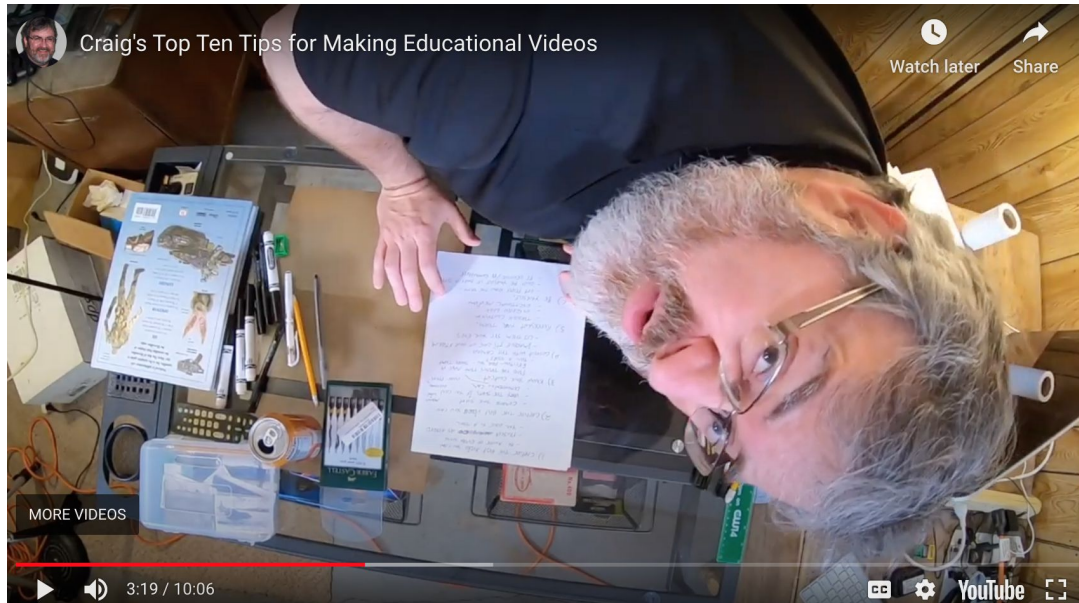
## Tips & Tricks from Mr. Craig Engagement with Video

- *Multiple camera angles & speed for demos on YouTube videos*





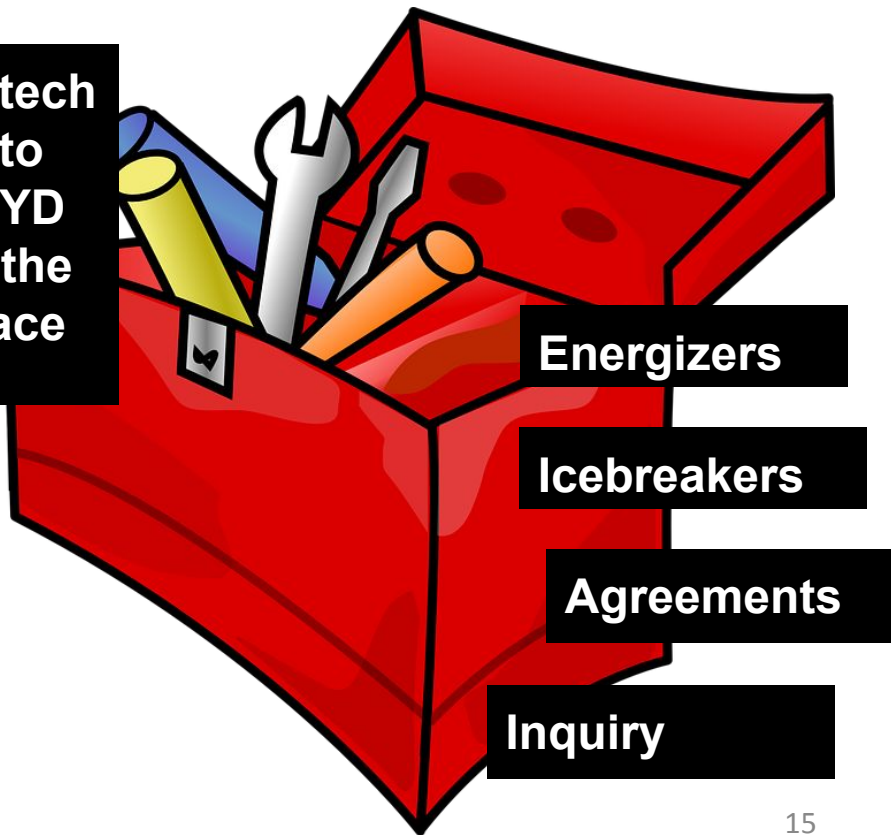
